

## EDITORIAL

This is already the second volume in the new layout; it does not contain, however, additional digital material which accompanied the previous IX volume. We would therefore like to kindly encourage the Authors to make use of already mentioned opportunities and attach files which will be published on a CD or DVD. They will thus extend the stock of published contents with, e.g., illustrations and databases/catalogues which could not be printed due to their format or size.

The part “Studies and Materials” in the present volume is indeed dominated by papers concerning the archaeology of Roman provinces. On the other hand, the part “Chronicle of Excavations” significantly extended its territorial scope. It is with great satisfaction that we welcome the report from Peru.

It is also worth stressing that we have maintained our cooperation with missions which carry out their research under the aegis of units of the University of Warsaw other than the Institute of Archaeology. We do hope that this cooperation will continue, also by means of publications of more extensive reports of fieldwork and desk-based studies in “Światowit.”

Looking ahead, we can suggest an excellent opportunity to prepare such papers which will summarise several campaigns of excavations or research projects which were carried out both at the Institute and other units. In five years, in 2019, we will celebrate two magnificent anniversaries – the 120<sup>th</sup> anniversary of publication of the first volume of “Światowit” and the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of foundation of the Chair of Archaeology at the University of Warsaw. We therefore encourage to celebrate these anniversaries also by means of publications with proper significance, size and scope. This is still a somehow distant perspective. However, bearing in mind a special nature of both concurrent jubilees, we take the liberty of reminding of them now.
