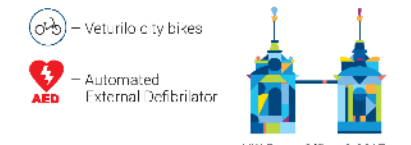
MAIN CAMPUS MAP

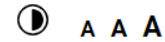

- The courses consists typically of 90 minutes meetings, taking place every week at the same time and place
- The academic calendar provides dates when the holidays, brakes and exams are scheduled (course-free time for students)
- The lecturers have appointed office hours when students can visit
- Students are required to not be late to a class (up to 15 min. can be tolerated) and wait for the lecturers up to 15 min. in case they are late (academic quarter)
- Some classes requires attendance to be graded

Overview

The study programme extensively covers new trends in archaeological research and archaeology's social function. Our course focuses mostly on Mediterranean archaeology, providing students with the elementary knowledge and practical skills that will enable them to participate in excavations anywhere around the world.

The programme includes a wide range of courses on general topics in archaeology, as well as depth courses on prehistoric and ancient societies of the Near East, Egypt, Greece, Roman Provinces and the Americas. Simultaneously, our course focuses on practical archaeological methods, field documentation, data acquisition and processing techniques, a modern academic practice, or museology, which prepares students for exhibition and cooperation with cultural institutions.

A significant element within the programme is field training: field walking surveys and excavations led by researchers affiliated with the Faculty



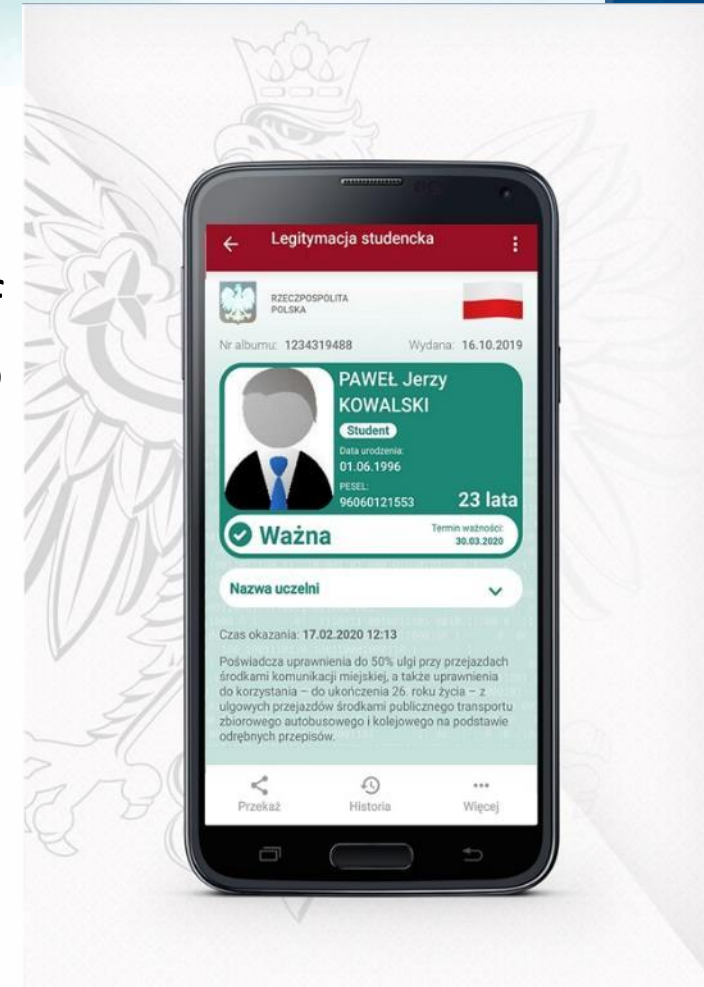

Rules for contacting at the University of Warsaw

- In correspondence, please always use an e-mail placed in the student domain (@student.uw.edu.pl) – this is a confirmation that the e-mail is written by an authorised person.
- In the title of the e-mail, please provide information about what is going on – it will make it easier to find the person who will best deal with the case.
- Please sign your name and album number – this will make it easier to identify the person in the system and speed up the process of replying to the message. Giving a year of study also does not hurt.
- Please do not write separate e-mails on the same topic; it is better to continue the thread already started – if you write a separate e-mail, it will make it difficult for us to find ourselves in the case and extend the waiting time for our response.
- Use appropriate forms of courtesy. If you write to an administration, authorities, or lecturer, it is official correspondence and should present such a style. Similarly, pay attention to how oral statements are formulated – too colloquial statements may tune your interlocutor negatively and not bring the expected effect.

ID card and ticket

- The Electronic Student Card is also a library card for BUW, you can code public transport tickets and parking fees on it.
- UwU students can use a mobile ID card, the validity of which is extended automatically. To obtain it, you need to install the Mobile USOS and mObywatel applications.

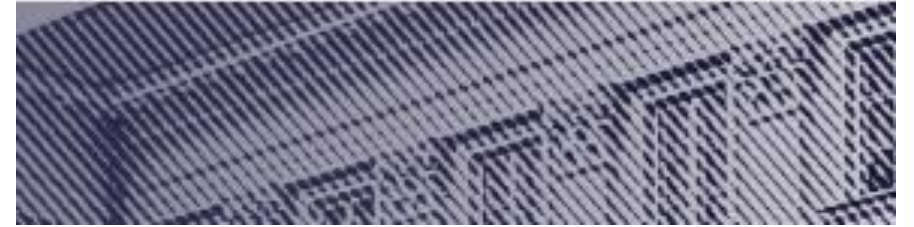

USOSweb – an electronic system for students

- USOSweb is a system that in many cases provides access to information that was formerly available only in the Dean's Office: courses schedule, grades, information about courses and lecturers
- USOSweb in many situations helps students avoid the need to appear in the Dean's Office: allows sending applications to the dean, scholarship applications, fill out surveys, payments, student exchange, etc.
- USOS uses its own terms:
 - Cycle = academic year/semester (2021/2021Z/2021L)
 - Study term = year of study (I year = AR-1)

Token registration

Linkage - committing to a course

- Linking in is the equivalent of the old entry of the object into the paper index
- Each student who finishes a cycle of studies and wants to get an entry for the next stage must take care of indicating which subjects they have passed within a given study programme, which of them are to be taken into account when finishing a given cycle, and which are extracurricular subjects.

Linkage



- You can link courses yourself only to the current cycle!
- You really have to keep an eye on it – the attached item = the item required to be passed!
- There is no connection = there is no credit!
- Resignation from completing classes is possible only on dates set by the academic calendar!
- Unlinking from the program – by application to the dean!

Representatives and solving up problems

- Students are adult citizens and therefore, deal with matters in person
- In the case of the so-called higher necessity, the matter for the student can be settled by the direct family with clear authorisation from the student provided by the interested party himself.
- Even the immediate family is not given information about the student without his consent (GDPR!)
- Any other person must present a notarial authorisation

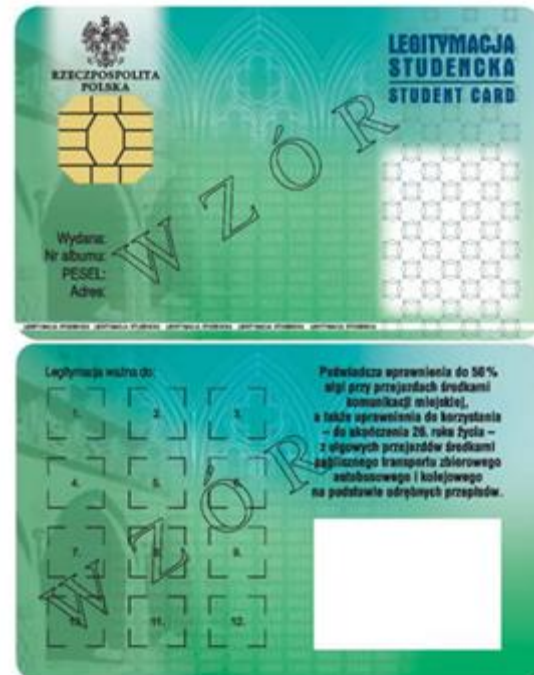

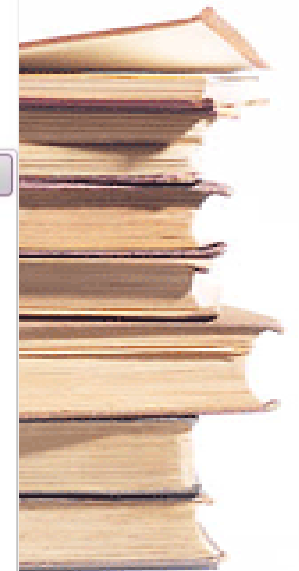

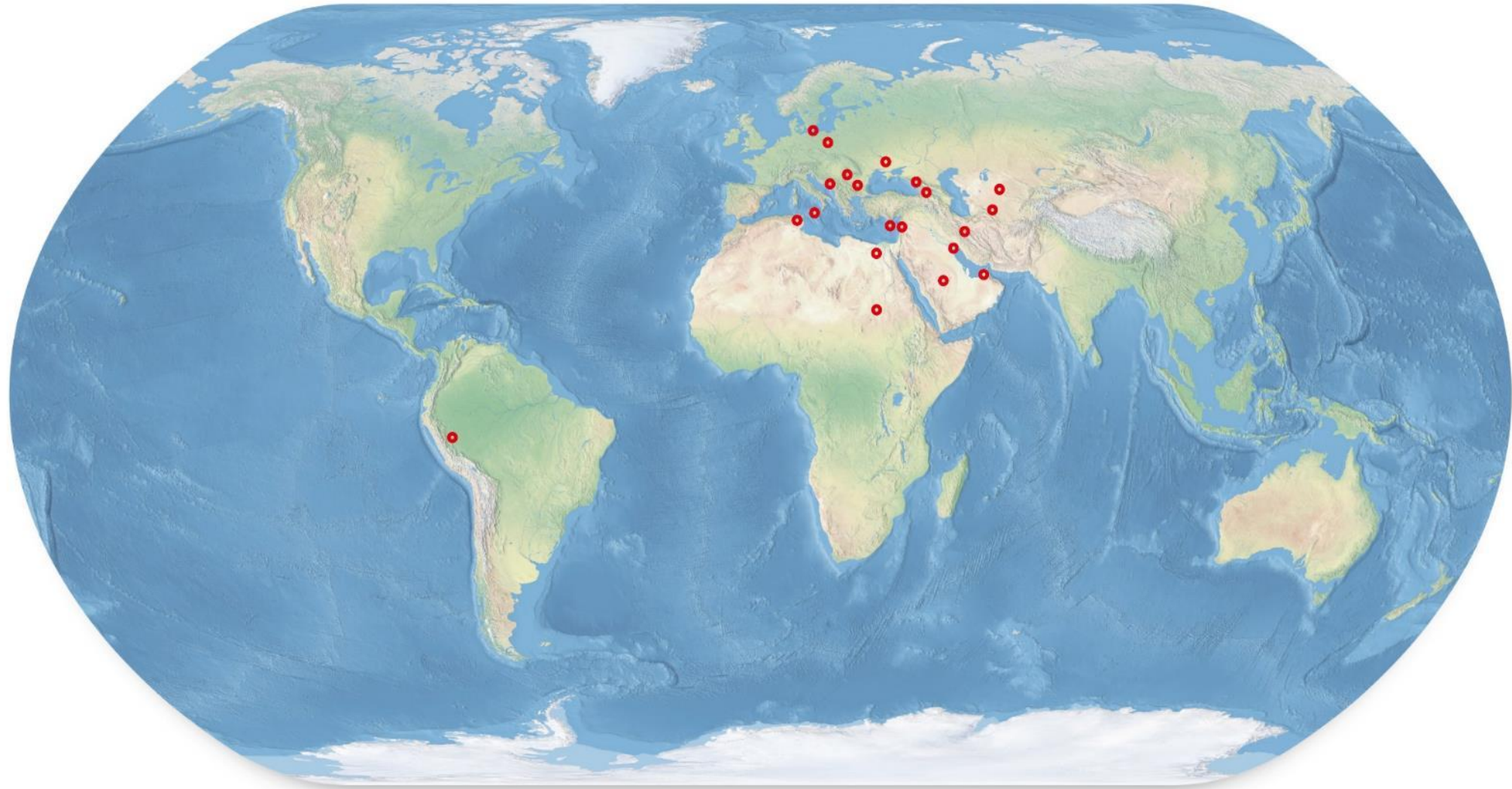

- There are several science clubs at our Faculty. Students associated with them take an active part in the scientific life of the Faculty, organising and co-organizing scientific conferences of national and international scope, as well as student scientific tours and Days of the Archaeologist, etc.
- They participate in various scientific undertakings, presenting their own scientific experience, as well as in the Festival in Biskupin.

Who is an ombudsman?

- An Ombudsperson is an independent and neutral person to whom students, academics and administrative staff can turn informally and confidentially for help in matters concerning the university and its community.

When to turn to the Ombudsman?

If you feel you have noticed a problem that affects the academic community or your functioning in it, you should turn to the Ombudsman for assistance. The principles of confidentiality and informality guiding the activity of the Ombudsman guarantee that reporting a case will not have negative consequences for the reporting party.

You may contact the Ombudsman in the following situations:



- ✓ If you need an opinion from an outsider or someone who will hear your problems in strict confidence and advise on the further course of action;
- ✓ If you need assistance in resolving a complicated matter, which you cannot handle on your own;
- ✓ If you think you have been treated unfairly;
- ✓ If you are in conflict that affects your functioning at the university;
- ✓ If you need a mediator or a facilitator;
- ✓ If you do not know who to address with your problem.

The Ombudsman Office hours are Monday and Thursday from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.

The Ombudsman office is open from Monday to Friday between 8.00 a.m. and 16.00 p.m.

It is advisable to make an appointment in advance. You may also visit the Ombudsman during her office hours without an appointment but since priority is given to the scheduled visitors, this may result in a long wait or the need to come back another time.
